### **Program Accomplishments**

4 -Only Mt. St. Joe, Towson Catholic, St. Frances and Loyola have reached the MIAA "A" conference playoffs in each of the last four seasons ('05-'06, '06-'07, '07-'08, '08-'09).

In Coach Davalli's first 4 years at the helm the Dons have finished:

2005-2006 16-12

2006-2007 16-12

2007-2008 18-10

2008-2009 19-13

First time since 1975-1979 to have four consecutive winning seasons.

This year's team...

- took 50 charges, the most ever by a Davalli coached team.
- out rebounded opponents on the year by 187 rebounds (901 to 714).
- made 50 more field goals than last year's team (603 - 553).

- grabbed 178 more rebounds than any other Davalli coached Loyola team (901 - 723).
- attempted 425 more free throws than our opponents.
- made more FTs (389) than our opponents attempted (355).
- gave up 50 less free throws to opponents than any other Davalli coached team (355 this year to 405 during the 2006-07 season).
- surrendered only 22 rbd's per game to opponents, which is almost 2.5 less rebounds than any other Davalli coached team.

Coach Davalli in just four seasons as head coach is 1 win shy of 70 wins (69 - 47 for a .681 winning percentage).

34 -Assistant Coach, and former Mt. St. Joe Coach, and Cardinal Gibbons standout, Pat Maggio completed his 34th year of coaching basketball.

### **Individual Accomplishments**

Senior, Matt Rum finished his career with:

85 career games played, 1191 points, 137 three pointers, 117 assists, 1000 career shots, 43% career field goal percentage, and 15 career 20+ point performances (3, 30+ point performances)

Senior, Brandon Floyd finished his career with:

84 career games played, 523 points, 49% career field goal percentage, 413 rebounds, 7 career 10+ rebound performances, 5 career double-doubles (pts/rbds) and 25 career charges

Senior, Terence Garvin finished the season with:

223 points (45% field goal percentage), 221 rebounds, 9 career 10+ rebound performances, 3 career double-doubles (pts/rbds) and 10 charges

Senior, Trevor Dauses finished his career with:

70 career games played, 213 points, 48% career field goal percentage, and 13 charges

Junior, Mike Fitzpatrick finished the season with:

32 games played (only player on team to play in all 32 games), 93 assists, 25 three pointers, and 79/91 from the free throw line (87%)

### **That is Interesting...**

3, 3, 240 Three of Loyola's Seniors Matt Rum, Brandon Floyd, and Trevor Dauses all played 3 years of varsity basketball under Coach Davalli, Coach Maggio, and Coach Bauer combining to play in 240 career games. The trio contributed in 53 of coach Davalli's 69 career wins, and combined for over 1,900 points, 827 rebounds, 206 assists, and 43 charges.
