The Dons this week were able to capture two very important victories in regards to their respective leagues: the Baltimore Catholic League and the MIAA 'A' Conference.

On Tuesday night, Loyola hosted St. Maria Goretti from Hagerstown. The visiting Gaels provided a tough contest in the first half. Goretti led by one point after the first quarter, and at halftime was down just three. The Dons' offense then exploded in the second half, outscoring Goretti 33-19. Loyola was led by Matt Rum's 17 points, followed by Brandon Floyd who tipped in 12. Goretti was out-rebounded by Loyola 49-17. The senior forward tandem of Trevor Dausess and Terence Garvin both grabbed 13 rebounds apiece. Goretti's leading scorer, junior point guard Nic Martin was held to eight points on the night. Martin had 18 in the first contest versus Loyola.

The Dons traveled up I-70 last night and prevailed over a tough St. John's team 65-55. The Dons did their job on the defensive side of the ball versus the host Vikings. St. John's Catholic Prep's Navy-bound senior forward, Troy King, was limited to four points on the contest and no three-pointers. As a team, the Dons held the Vikings to 1/19 shooting from beyond the arc. Loyola was sparked by Matt Rum's team-high 19 points, while junior guard Matt Mathias drained two three's and finished with 14. The win brings the Dons' 'A' Conference record to 8-7, and tied with Mount St. Joseph for fifth place in the standings.

Head coach Andy Bauer, a longtime JV coach at St. Joe, is now in his second year running the Severn, Maryland program. Leading the Cavaliers is senior guard Andre Moore. Bauer's arsenal also features Cliff Jones, a sturdy forward, and Paul Graziano, a three-point specialist.

Following tonight's action, the Dons will visit John Carroll on Sunday for an important 'A' Conference match-up, and then Loyola will end their regular season with the team's Senior Night on Tuesday with St. Frances.
